# Product Introduction

The Hardware Updater application has been designed to provide end users with a simple application to update hardware firmware on all devices that offer user update interfaces. These devices include the XR ResponseCard, and the ResponseCard AnyWhere. The Hardware Updater application connects to the host server at TurningTechnologies in order to provide the end user with the most current firmware available. With just a few mouse clicks, your device will be updated to the latest version of firmware.

# System Requirements

Like TurningPoint, the Hardware Updater is designed for use on computers with typical abilities so you do not need the very latest technology or a large amount of hard disk space to use the Hardware Updater. There are some basic requirements for hardware and software. These are detailed in the sections below.

## Requirements for Hardware

The following hardware specifications are required before installing the Hardware Updater on a computer:

The following software applications are required to use the Hardware Updater:

- OS X 10.3 or higher.
- An active connection to the internet.

In a few simple steps, you can install the Hardware Updater on your computer. The installation process takes only a few minutes, then you will be ready to update the firmware on your XR Card, or ResponseCard AnyWhere.

# Using the Hardware Updater

The Hardware Updater application connects to the host server at TurningTechnologies in order to provide the end user with the most current firmware available. The Firmware Updater also allows you to install firmware for other supported languages. Currently supported languages include English, Dutch, French, German, Portuguese, and Spanish.

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## Step by Step Instructions

- 1 Connect** your XR ResponseCard or ResponseCard AnyWhere to your computer with a mini USB cable.

- 2 Double Click on the Hardware Updater icon.

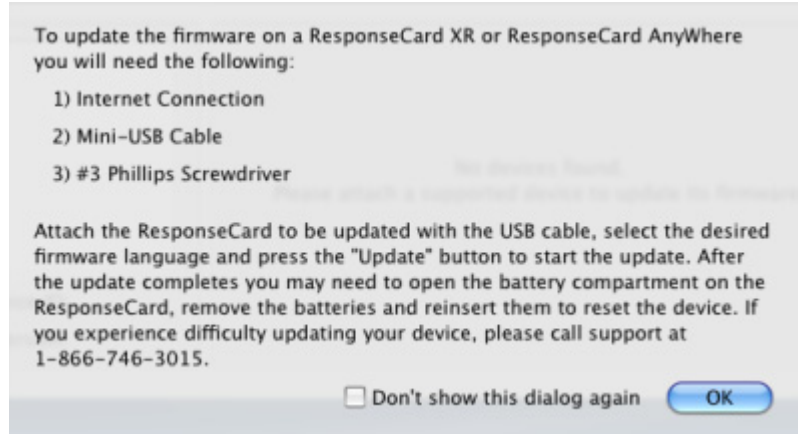

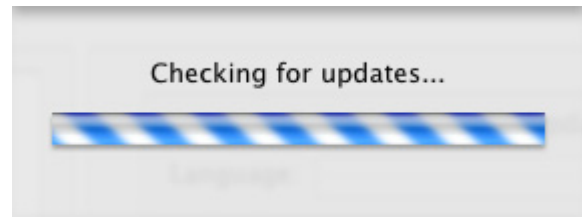
- 3 Click **ok** to close the list of items needed to complete the update.

- 4 The updater will now check for the latest versions of firmware available for your device.



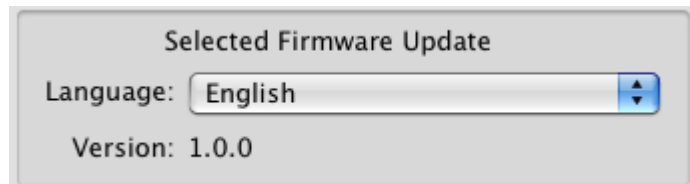
- a. The Hardware Updater will display the detected device and its current firmware version.

- 5 Select the **language** for the firmware.

**Selected Language**



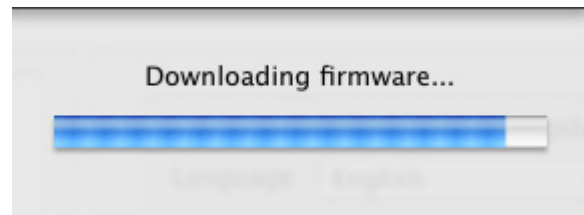
**Tip** The version number will turn red if the firmware that is selected in the updater application is the same version that is already loaded onto the hardware device.

- 6 Click **Update**.

**Warning** DO NOT UNPLUG THE DEVICE DURING THE UPDATE!

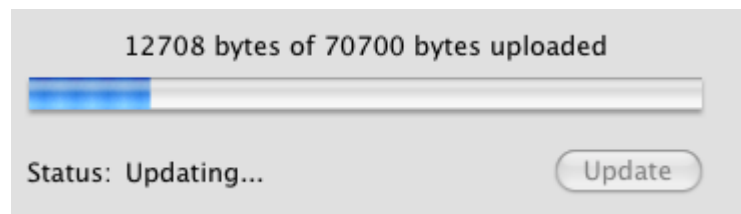
- 7 The Hardware Updater will now connect to the server and download the latest firmware.

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## Step by Step Instructions Setting up a successful update sound.

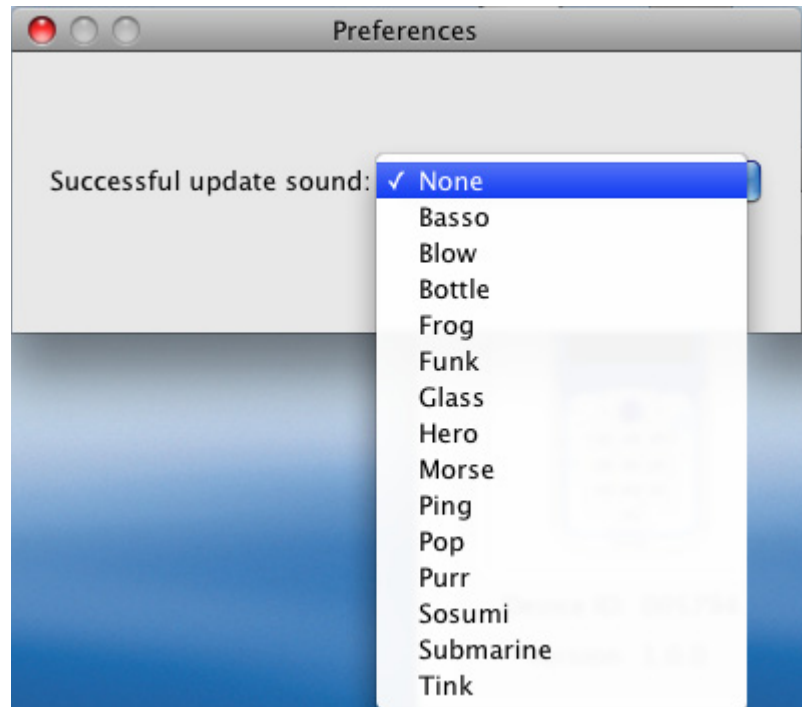
**1** Click Hardware Updater in the toolbar.
