

Non-Activation vs. Activated vPads

vPads that are set to non-activation mode do not require a 16 digit alphanumeric license code to activate them. However, a vPad that is set to non-activation mode must connect to a host computer that is running TurningPoint that is activated with a special code that allow a non-activated vPad connection.

vPads that are activated can connect to a host computer that is either activated with a special code that allows for non-activated vPads or a normal activation code.

*** Note: vPads, activated or non-activated, must be on the same network as the host computer.
