## Minimum System Requirements:

- Chromebooks running OS 54 or above
- Chromebooks running OS 57 or later settings:
  1. Make sure ExamView Student is closed.
  2. Open Chrome.
  3. In the address bar of the Chromebook, type the following: `chrome://settings/content/flash`
  4. Choose the slider to allow sites to run Flash.

Notes:

- If the screen says “Block sites from running Flash,” the slider is gray and you are allowing sites to run Flash.

- If the screen says “Allow sites to run Flash” or “Ask first,” the slider is blue and you are blocking sites from running Flash.

5. Click ADD to the right of Allow.
6. Enter `examview-student.com` and click ADD.
7. Close Chrome.
8. Open ExamView Student.

NOTE: ExamView Student may show up in the list under Block. As long as the slider is gray and `examview-student.com` has been added under Allow, ExamView Student should work as expected.

- Wi-Fi connection (recommended for optimal performance) or data connection
